

Keystone Manufacturing opens Grand Rapids site

GRAND RAPIDS -- Kalamazoo-based [Keystone](#) Manufacturing has opened its new Southeast Grand Rapids location.

The 9,000-square-foot facility, at 3710 Sysco Drive SE, will house operations for manufacturing, assembly, packing and distribution of medical devices and supplies.

It brings eight employees in a variety of areas and doubles the company's capacity, said principal and co-owner Mike Zamora.

There are 15 employees at the Kalamazoo location.

Zamora said the contract manufacturer is hoping to capitalize on a prime Grand Rapids market in the medical supply industry.

Keystone Manufacturing is a subsidiary of Keystone Solutions Group, which provides product development, supply chain management and contract manufacturing services for the medical device, automotive, aerospace and specialty products industries.

Zamora said the Grand Rapids facility will help meet growing demand.

A member of the West Michigan Medical Device Consortium, the firm collaborates with other suppliers, helping the company grow, Zamora said.

Keystone Solutions Group started its medical supply manufacturing business in the past year.

The company, which in July changed its name to Keystone from Alliant Engineering, performs manufacturing, assembly, packing and distribution of medical devices and supplies.
